Resident Assistant Qualifications

Every applicant must meet the stated qualifications in order to go through the R.A. selection process. If you do not meet all of these requirements the Housing Department will not accept your application.

1. Must have a Cumulative G.P.A. of 2.30. First semester freshman can use their high school G.P.A. to qualify for the position.
2. Must provide three completed candidate recommendation forms.

Resident Assistant positions are made on a semester basis. Reappointments **are not automatic** for the succeeding semester, but will be made on an evaluation of prior performance. Based on justifiable reasons, a Resident Assistant position may be terminated at any time during the semester. For example, violations of residence hall or campus policies are examples of justifiable reasons. If a Resident Assistant's semester G.P.A. falls below 2.30 they will have one semester to raise the average and will have to participate in the academic assistance program.

*Applications are due by Friday, July 24, 2009. Interviews will be conducted Monday, August 3, 2009 & Tuesday, August 4, 2009. If selected, you will report for RA training on Wednesday, August 12, 2009.
