Admission Procedure

1. Submit completed application to EMCC Admission Office. (Acceptance to EMCC does not guarantee acceptance to the RN program.)
2. Submit School of Nursing application to Nursing Department, Room 141.
3. Submit official high school transcript from accredited high school or GED.
4. Submit official transcripts from all colleges previously attended.
5. Applicants must have:
 - ACT minimum composite score of 19, with 19 in reading
 - Grade of "C" or higher in College Algebra, Microbiology, and Anatomy and Physiology I & II.
 - Completed prerequisite science classes in the last 5 years.
 - Cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher on 4-point scale for all previous college work attempted.
 - A TEAS score of at least 50% (Must meet minimal ACT score prior to taking the TEAS)
