Enrolling in AFROTC

- -Attend AFROTC Orientation

- -Register for Aerospace Studies class at EMCC

Fall: AFR 1111 and AFR 1121 Spring: AFR 1211 and AFR 1221

Program Requirements

- -Must have 3-5 years left in college career
- -Maintain a cum GPA 2.0 (2.5 if on Air Force scholarship)
- -Register for ROTC through EMCC, but attend AS Class, Physical Training, and Leadership Lab at Mississippi State
- -Meet AF BMI standards
- -Pass Fitness Assessment each semester
- -Meet Department of Defense Medical Standards
- -After Sophomore year, must transfer to MSU or another AFROTC 4 year school

Weekly Commitment

- -Physical Training (PT) 2-3x per week
- -Aerospace Studies classes
- -Leadership Lab (LLAB) 1x per week

- -Competitive, academic scholarship
- -Apply at www.afrotc.com
- -Deadline to apply HS senior year

In-College Scholarship Program (ICSP)

- -ACT score and GPA minimums do apply, contact detachment for more info
- -Spring Semester-Freshman Year
- -Fall Semester-Sophomore Year
- -No application, students who qualify are submitted by Detachment
