

EMCC is proud to announce that the Division of Instruction decided to implement eBooks and digital content into selected courses. More than 50 sections of courses will be considered E-sections and these sections will use eBooks as the primary textbook source.

Students and advisors will be able to recognize an E-section by the “E” designation in the course section number (e.g., GT01E, GT02E, etc.). As a student enrolled in an E-section, the eBook and other digital content will reside in your Canvas space, which is easily accessible through the LEO portal, using a desktop or laptop computer, tablet, smartphone, etc. As an end user, you will receive specific details for each eBook assigned to you, including any other downloading or printing options.

To ensure consistent and affordable access to instructional material, an eBook will be assigned to 100% of the students enrolled in an E-section of a course. So, when you enroll in an E-section of a course, you are automatically assigned an eBook and the cost is added to your tuition and fees for that course, as opposed to a separate cost assessed in the EMCC Bookstore or some other retail source used for purchasing textbooks. Regardless of your Financial Aid status, your eBook is automatically charged to your student account and can be paid for just like all of your other tuition and fees, but you will achieve a significant savings when compared to traditional printed textbooks.
