

HELPFUL HINTS FOR STUDENTS

- 1. Decals **ARE** required to be displayed on the back left rear glass of the vehicle.
- Temporary decals (for a car you do not normally drive) can be obtained from Linda McCool in the Dean of Student's Office.
- 3. Do **NOT** park in the reserved or visitor parking area(s).
- 4. Do **NOT** park in a handicapped space unless you have a designated parking permit to do so. If

you have someone else's handicapped parking permit, this does not allow you to park in the

handicapped parking area(s).

- 5. Do **NOT** park in the grass at any time.
- 6. Student ID's must be on students at **ALL** times while on campus.
- 7. NO children are allowed on campus or in the classrooms during normal class time.
- 8. NO animals or pets are allowed on campus at any time.
- 9. NO loud music on campus at ANY TIME.
